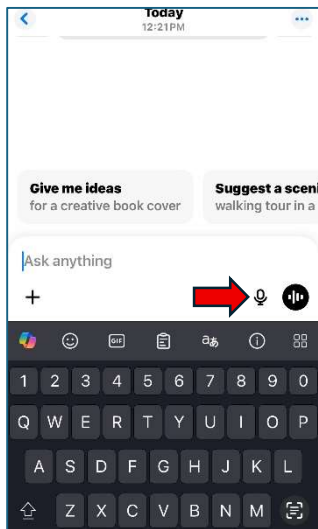

You talk, ChatGPT talks back—like chatting with a super bright, always-ready-to-help friend. You can even choose the voice you want to hear, adding a little personality to your assistant.

So, whether you're tossing out ideas while walking the dog, asking for a dinner recipe while cooking, or just curious about something and want to *talk it out*, ChatGPT's voice tools make it easier—and way more fun—to connect.

Using Voice Input: Step-by-Step


This method lets you *speak your message* and then read ChatGPT's text reply on screen. It's perfect for quick notes, questions, or inconvenient typing.

How to Use Voice Input:



1. Open the ChatGPT app on your phone or visit the ChatGPT website on your computer (make sure your mic is enabled).
2. Start a new chat or open an existing one.
3. Tap the microphone icon next to the message box (on mobile). On desktop, it may appear after clicking inside the chat field.
4. Speak your question or message. ChatGPT will transcribe your voice into text.
5. Once you stop talking, ChatGPT will process your input and respond with text on the screen.
6. You can now continue the conversation by voice or switch back to typing at any time.

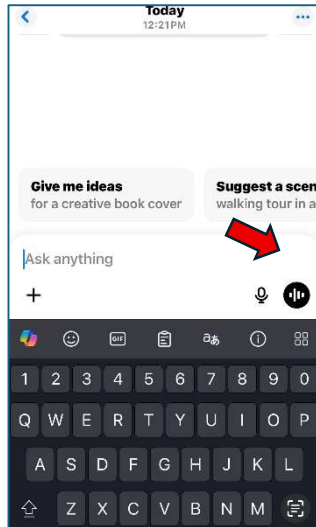


 **Tip:** This is best for situations where you'd rather talk than type but still want to read and save the response.

👤 Using Voice Conversation: Step-by-Step

This feature provides a full two-way spoken conversation—You talk, and ChatGPT responds. It's like having a live dialogue with a helpful assistant.

How to Start a Voice Conversation:



1. Open the ChatGPT app on your phone (voice conversation is currently app-only).
2. Tap the four-line sparkle icon. This icon represents the Voice Conversation feature.
3. Choose your preferred voice from the available options (e.g., Breeze, Ember, Juniper, etc.).
4. Once activated, say something aloud like “What’s the weather today?” or “Tell me a fun fact.”
5. ChatGPT will respond out loud in the voice you selected. No typing needed!
6. You can carry on the conversation naturally—ask follow-ups, change topics, or just chat freely.



✅ **Tip:** *Voice Conversation creates a more relaxed, spontaneous interaction—ideal for brainstorming, practicing speech, or hands-free use while cooking, walking, or driving.*

Choosing a different voice can enhance how we connect with a topic or audience. For example, someone might use a more enthusiastic or animated tone when talking about a favorite movie, but switch to a calm, thoughtful voice when discussing a serious news story. Adjusting your voice helps express emotion, set the tone, and keep conversations more engaging and meaningful.
